About Us



Community Christian School was founded in 1984 by Elaine Thomason. Ms. Elaine saw the need for Christian education in Cherokee County when she began the school. Her goal was to provide an affordable education centered around Christ. The school has seen a lot of growth throughout its 39 years.



We opened a newly constructed building which houses grades K-5th beginning with the 2020-21 school year. After Ms. Elaine's passing, CCS partnered with Covenant Christian Academy in Cumming, GA to carry the legacy of both of our schools into the future.

Covenant Christian Academy is fully accredited by the Georgia Association of Christian Schools, American Association of Christian Schools, North American Christian School Accrediting Agency, National Council for Private School Accreditation, and AdvancEd. Thus, all CCS transcripts are recognized by the Georgia Private School Accreditation Council (GAPSAC) and accepted by every school in every nation. CCS has received provisional accreditation beginning with the 2020-21 school year.

Our Statement of Faith



1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16: 2 Peter 1:21; John 10:30).

2. We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. He is omnipotent; that is, He can do all things. He is omnipresent; that is, He is present to all creation and has under His immediate authority all things which are in Heaven, in the earth, and under the earth. He is omniscient; that is, He knows all things. He readily exercises His power which is present everywhere, and to Him, there is nothing that is impossible or unknown, that is, He knows what has been from eternity, what now takes place everywhere, and what will be to all eternity (Genesis 1:1; Matthew 28:19; John 10:30).



3. We believe in the deity of Christ, His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracles, His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, His bodily resurrection, His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and His personal return in power and glory (Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:23; Mark 16:19; Luke 1:35; John 2:11, 10:33, 11:25; Acts 1:11; I Corinthians 15:3-4; Ephesians 1:7; Hebrews 2:9, 4:15, 7:26; Revelation 19:11).

4. We believe in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature; men are justified by the shed blood of Christ; and we are saved by God's grace through faith alone (John 3:16-21, 5:24; Romans 3:23, 5:8-9; Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 3:5).

5. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; the saved unto the resurrection of life, and the lost to the resurrection of damnation (John 5:28-29).

6. We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:9; I Corinthians 12:12-13; Galatians 3:26-28).

7. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (Romans 8:13-14; I Corinthians 3:16, 6:19-20; Ephesians 4:30, 5:18).

8. We believe that all human life is sacred and created by God in His image. Human life is of inestimable worth in all its dimensions, including pre-born babies, the aged, the physically or mentally challenged, and every other stage or condition from conception through natural death. We are therefore called to defend, protect, and value all human life. (Job 12:10; Psalm 139; Isaiah 49:5; Jeremiah 1:5; Ephesians 2:10.).

9. We believe that every believer should strive to walk by the Spirit and engage in a lifestyle that stimulates a Christ-centered maturation in their lives as well as the lives of those around them. Christians should strive to both identify and flee from influences and practices which hinder an individual from maturing in their relationship with Christ. The Bible warns that immorality of any type, including but not limited to sexual immorality in any form, idolatry, theft, greed, and drunkenness may disqualify us from inheriting the kingdom of God. Moreover, all believers are to engage in gospel conversations, to live Christ-honoring lives, and to work continuously towards the spread of the gospel to all nations (Matthew 5:16, 28:19-20; Mark 16:15; John 20:21; Acts 1:8; Romans 6:1-14, 12:1-2; 1 Corinthians 6:9-20; 2 Corinthians 5:20, 6:14-7:1; Galatians 5:16-25; Colossians 3:1-17; James 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17)



Admissions



Non-Discrimination

Community Christian School admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. CCS practices a biblical philosophy of admissions. It does not discriminate upon the basis of race, sex, or national origin, but upon the student's intellectual, moral, and personal qualifications in administration of its educational policies, scholarship, athletic, and other school administered programs.

Rates and fees listed below are effective with the 2023-2024 academic year.

Annual Tuition and Fees

- Kindergarten 8th Grade Annual Tuition: \$7,800
- Kindergarten 8th Grade Registration and Curriculum Fee: \$400
- Kindergarten 8th Grade Application Fee (Non-Refundable): \$100
- Pre-K4 (Half Day) Annual Tuition: \$3,600
- Pre-K4 (Half Day) Registration and Curriculum Fee: \$200
- Pre-K4 (Half Day) Application Fee (Non-Refundable): \$100

Registration and Curriculum Fee

The total Registration and Curriculum Fee includes teaching supplies, student textbooks, student record maintenance, and standardized testing. Please note, THE ENROLLMENT FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE. Textbooks will not be ordered and your child's place is not confirmed until the Registration and Curriculum Fee has been received in full.

Additional Expenses

Please note that additional expenses such as uniforms, field trips, lunch fees, yearbook and pictures are not included in the annual tuition.

Early Withdrawal Penalty

Families who withdraw prior to the end of the school year will be charged for tuition through the end of the semester during which they withdraw. For example, if a student is withdrawn in November, their account will be charged through December. Please be advised that records will be withheld until a student's account is cleared. Appeals to this penalty will be entertained in circumstances that are severe in nature. All appeals will be addressed by the board of directors.

Application Process



Step 1: Contact Us

Contact the school office and setup a meeting with our Principal, Alyssa Rettig. She will sit down with you and discuss CCS in detail and answer your questions about the school. She will also provide you with a tour of our facilities.

Step 2: Shadow

Consider planning a shadowing experience for your child. While this is not required, it is highly encouraged.

Step 3: Complete an Application

As God leads, download and complete our <u>Student Application</u>. During this part of the process you will have various forms to read and sign. Some of these forms will pertain to your child's history at his or her current or previous school(s). Please submit the completed application to the school office.

Step 4: Receive an Application Decision

Once a student's application is complete, an admissions decision will be reached as quickly as possible. Families will then be notified of the school's decision. The timeline of this process ultimately depends on the promptness of the application being completed. Please do not hesitate to contact the school office and setup a meeting.
